St Peter's Church was built as a

result of a competition in 1824 to design a new chapel on the Steine.

In 1873 St Peter's became the Parish Church of Brighton. The church hall next to the building was built in 1927 as a memorial to those killed in the First World War.

Works consisted of erection of scaffolding externally and internally for roof covering replacement and repairs to the roof structure with the rebuilding of a repaired pinnacle on the Tower.

Various stone work and timber repairs on the Nave and Clerestory were also carried out.

The renewal of roof coverings with repairs to the roof structure together with plaster work repairs and redecoration to the East and West Aisles was also undertaken. The installation of Lightning protection was also a part of the project.
