The role:

The **Underground Quarry Manager** will report directly to the Managing Director and work in close partnership with the Command Supervisor. The successful candidate will have mineral extractives experience, excellent organisational and management skills, geotechnical knowledge and a strong understanding of all aspects of Health & Safety and Environmental legislation. In addition, the successful candidate will have had proven appointed QR99 Reg 8.1c appointment (or similar) responsibilities.

The role will suit a self-motivated organised individual and you will have the opportunity to develop the scope of the role within the Company. You'll work alongside the highly experienced, specialist team and be willing to learn and develop your wider operational knowledge of our Underground operations. Excellent communication and team management/leadership skills are essential.

The successful candidate will:
