Lumley castle named after Sir Ralph Lumley who was a solider from the late 1300's, well known for his bravery in battles. Currently owned by the Earl of Lumley of the House of Scarborough, Lumley is now a luxurious hotel located in Chester-le-Street, County Durham.

Over the past few years a positive relationship has been built with Lumley Castle with Stone Technical Services Ltd completing various works, and because of the high standards and good customer service the relationship is on-going.

In order to renovate the West Terrace Stone needed to remove all defective York Sand Stone from the terrace to in order to create a new sub base this would allow a sufficient surface to input all the new, York Sand Stone. During works the terrace and castle was still open to the public, therefore works were completed in two phases so business wasn't interrupted.
